In 2010 the Kinship Care National Training and Outreach Service, run by CHILDREN 1st and funded by the Scottish Government, was set up to give information, advice and other support to kinship carers and children living across Scotland.

As part of the service we provide the national Kinship Care helpline run by ParentLine Scotland. The helpline is a free confidential service for anyone caring for a child in Scotland.

The helpline opening hours are: 9am-10pm Monday to Friday 12noon-8pm Saturday and Sunday

Training skills and development

Kinship carers have told us about areas and issues they'd like more information and support. These include topics such as financial matters, schooling, challenging behaviour, substance misuse and safe use of the internet.

We have listened and have put together our programme of informal workshops for 2012-2013.

The short workshops advertised in this booklet are available for you to meet other kinship carers, share your experiences and learn from others. They are delivered by staff from CHILDREN 1st and other appropriate organisations, to make sure you get the best possible advice.

These workshops are free, travel expenses can be reimbursed and we will cover the cost of childcare up to £20.00.

How do I apply?

Please have a look at our workshop themes. Once you or your group have decided which workshop you would like us to run please fill out the enclosed booking form and return it to the address provided.

We will hold the workshop when we have enough people - at least six, but more is always better! Once we have enough people signed up we will contact all individuals / groups to arrange an appropriate venue and time.

We are more than happy to deliver a workshop in your group meeting venue at a time that suits your group members.

Workshops

Financial Inclusion. Length of workshop: 2hrs

This workshop looks at financial entitlements, financial planning, types of borrowing and the financial implications of residence and permanency orders. It is delivered jointly by Citizen Advice Scotland and the kinship care helpline at ParentLine Scotland.

Hints & tips about school and learning. Length of workshop: 2hrs

This workshop provides an overview of what happens in school today, how you can support your child's learning and the kind of financial and practical support possibly available for your child. We will tell you about the new Curriculum for Excellence and how the school can support your child through additional learning and incidents of bullying.

Impact of substance misuse. Length of workshop: 2hrs

This workshop looks at the different ways substance misuse affects family relationships. We will provide information about how trauma, caused by parental substance misuse in a child's early years, can affect emotional and physical well-being. We will also look at the different organisations which can help families affected by substance misuse.

Challenging Behaviour. Length of workshop: 2hrs

This workshop looks at the role carers play in a child's life and how to successfully cope with raising children. We will explore challenging and difficult behaviour, possible reasons for the behaviour and how to successfully manage and support your child. We will also explore the importance of discipline and how rewarding positive behaviour can be an effective tool.

Safe internet use. Length of workshop: 2hrs

This workshop looks at modern technology and some of the potential risks it presents to children and young people. We will look at ways for you to protect your child(ren) and provide you with some basic skills to use the internet for homework and as a source of support and information.
